

### **Instructions to Students interested in SCCP Pre-Residency Track:**

For rising P2 and P3 students interested in the pre-residency track (PRT), please submit a brief letter of intent (no more than 1 page double-spaced) indicating your specific interest in and anticipated benefit by participating in the PRT. We also request you submit a current curriculum vita (CV) – remember, mentorship in this track will help format your CV for residency applications, so please do not panic if you feel your CV isn't *perfect* currently.

Please complete the application and upload your CV and brief letter of intent to the track coordinator (**USC: Bookstaver**) at [https://www.sccp.sc.edu/Pre-Residency\\_Track](https://www.sccp.sc.edu/Pre-Residency_Track). You will not receive an email confirmation specifically, however, you are welcome to follow-up this up with an email (without attachments) to verify your submission.

It is preferred you submit these documents by **August 30<sup>th</sup>** each year – however, we recognize that interests evolve over time, and we will consider this a rolling process for submitting your materials. We also recognize that some students may not apply for the PRT until P3 year due to evolving interests. If you are a P3 student interested in completing the Track but have not completed the required P2 tasks, you may petition to the residency track coordinator to be excused from those requirements. By submitting these documents, we will be able to formally track and assess your progress for preparing for residency training. It will also ensure you receive all appropriate e-communications.
